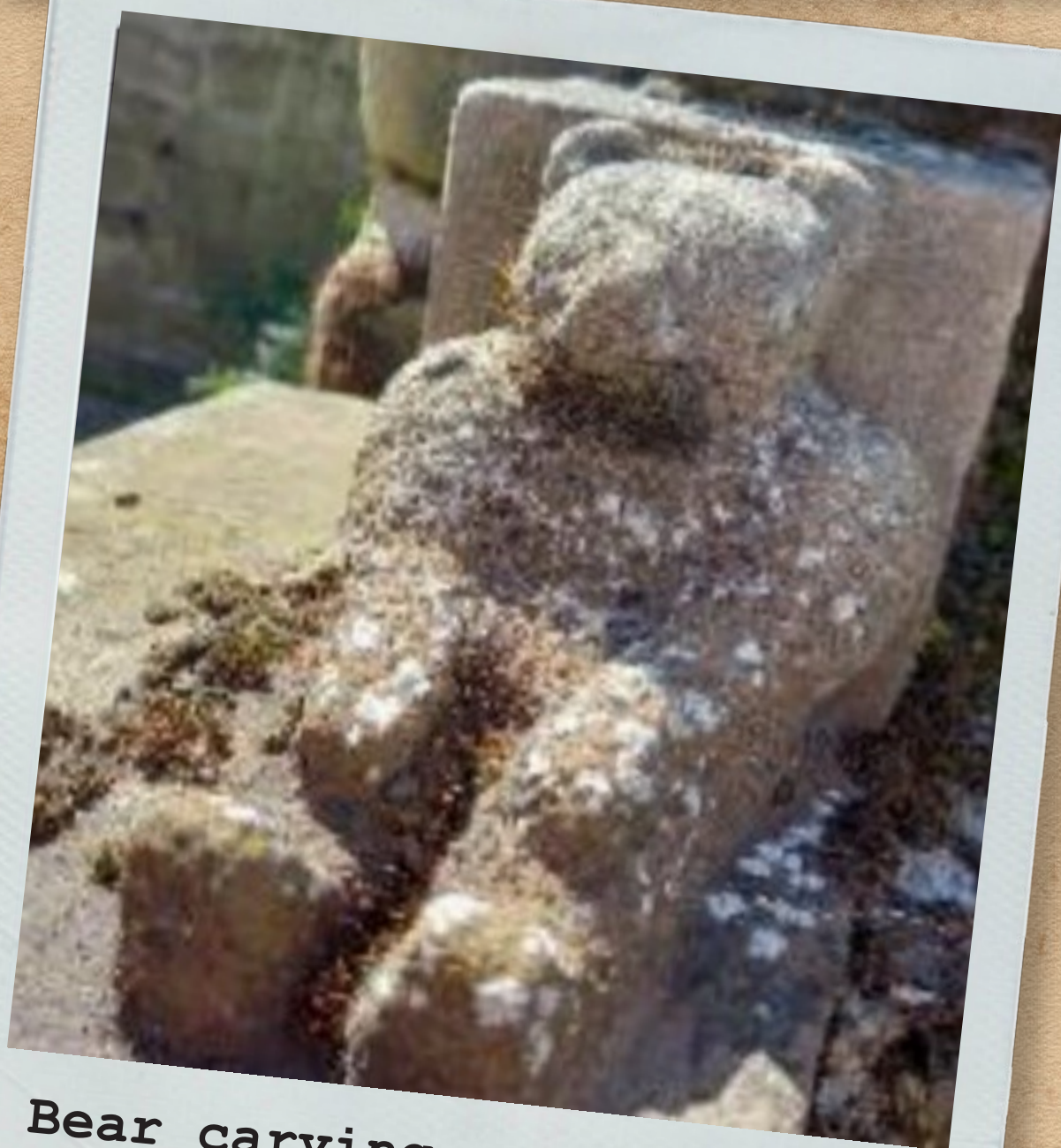


Old Moor Courtyard Stone Carvings

The stone carvings at Old Moor are of an unknown age. Some seem to have been carved about 30 years ago, but others appear to be older. These carvings can be spotted around the courtyard as you enter to the left of the welcome hut.



Bear carving – can be found to the left of the gates as you enter the courtyard.

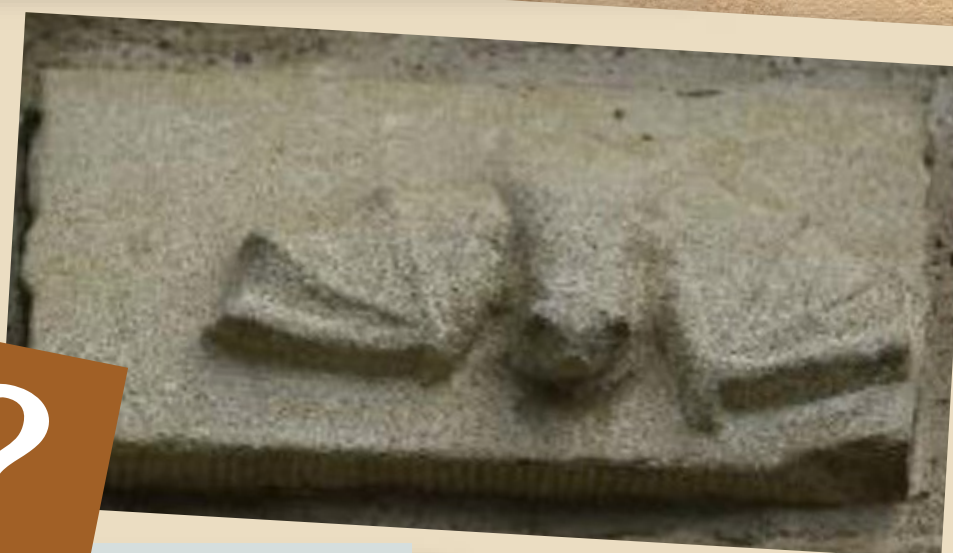


Gable end of Visitor Centre at the roofline.

Thought to be a likeness of a farmer at Old Moor, who had a large nose, but possibly not quite this large!

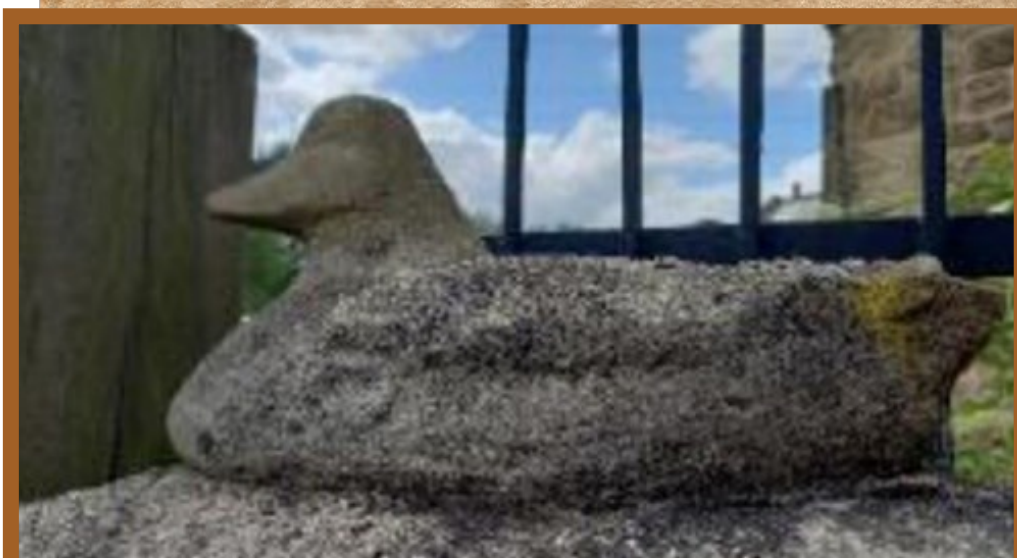


If you look above the doors of the visitor centre, you might be able to spot a number of bat carvings!
